

Side Tilt Carriage

Side Tilt Carriages - Rated by the fork carriage lifting capability, there are four sizes of hook type tine carriages. The hook type blade carriages have been standardized.

Class I carriages are rated for cargo as much as 2000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing utilized for Class I is 13 inches. Class II carriages are rated for loads up to 5,550 lbs. Their carriage bar spacing is 16 inches. Class III carriages are rated for loads up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is twenty inches. Class IV carriages are rated for loads as much as 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this capacity is 25 inches.

Pin mounted blades differ by the amount of offset between the blade and the blade eye. Various manufacturers will vary the carriages for pin type blades. Carriage capacity will be determined by the carriage pin size and by the tine size.
