Cascade Clamps - Founded in Portland, Oregon in 1943, the Cascade Manufacturing Company started as a small machine shop employing only four individuals. Overall sales for that year totaled \$60,000. The very first recorded sales revenues involved the machining and assembly of stainless steel pipe fittings, valves and different parts. Throughout five years of operation, the business had expanded to forty employees and their yearly sales volume had risen to 330 thousand dollars. Nowadays, Cascade is among the top international manufacturers in the material handling business.

Manufacture and design of the company's very first hydraulic cylinder paved the way in Cascade's aggressive quest of new business opportunities. During the last sixty years, the material handling trade has matured into a highly sophisticated area and Cascade has proudly played a part on this improvement. Cascade at the moment continues to develop as the premier provider of forklift attachments and various related products. The business feels confident in their capability to be able to continue to lead the way in the business by understanding customer's requirements in the future and remaining competitive within the world market.

During the 1950's, Cascade started to fabricate, design, and sell its hydraulic accessories. A brand new facility was made in the year 1956, in order to accommodate all the plant offices and operations in Portland, Oregon, which continues to be the company's present headquarters. After fifteen years of business, total staff reached a hundred and eighty staff and sales had reached almost two million three hundred thousand dollars.

The next production plant was built in the year 1959 in Springfield, McKinney. nineteen sixty marked Cascade's initial transfer into the international world of the material handling industry as the company recognized interest in Australia, the Netherlands and England.

In 1964, the company changed its name to the Cascade Corporation. Afterward in 1965, the business went public with a preliminary offering of 200,000 shares of common stock. Ever since then the company has expanded its manufacturing facilities within the continental US to the places Warner Robins Georgia to go along with its already present plants in Portland, Oregon and Springfield, McKinney. Cascade products are made internationally because of many subsidiary operations. In 1994, a brand new plant was accomplished in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European command center. This plant is designed to be the essential customer support centre.

Cascade further expanded their product base in 1996 and the year 1997 after buying five firms, which included the Kenhar Corporation, the international best in forks.
